

FOM Monthly Meeting

December 14, 2006

I. Call to Order

FOM President Bob Hedrick welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

II. Secretary's Report

The minutes were accepted.

III. Treasurer's Report

FOM Treasurer Linda Hedrick reported that there was an overall total of \$33,388.19 in the account.

IV. Old Business

Holiday Pies – Chairperson Scott Wilson reported that 56 students sold 498 items, taking in \$6,762. The pies will be delivered to the school on 12/19 between 3:00 and 4:00 p.m., with a pickup time of between 6:00 and 8:00 p.m.

Leaf Raking – Chairperson Allyson Jutras reported that 88 students and 23 chaperones raked this year to earn \$5,550. **Cabaret Table Raffle** – The raffle tickets, which can be purchased from any Executive Board member, will be on sale until the Cabaret tickets go on sale sometime in February. So far, FOM has sold \$160 worth of raffle tickets. **Holiday Concert** – The concert held on 12/7 took in \$1,187 at the door, \$761.50 at the scholarship raffle and bake sale and \$120 in Cabaret table raffle tickets. **Chili Fiesta** – Mr. Bastien reported that the Executive Board voted to change the date for the NH State Cook Off from June 3 to June 2 and there is a possibility of a 2 day event with FOM hosting the New England Regional, as well as the NH State Cook Off. **Papa Gino's Night** – Temporary Scholarship Chairperson Carol Martin reported that the fundraiser earned \$193.61 and introduced new Scholarship Chairperson, Kelly Garnick.

V. New Business

Volunteer Book – Volunteer Coordinator Dianne McDonald displayed the new Volunteer Book and gave instructions for logging volunteer hours.

VI. Other Business

Spring Band Trip – Chris Landry, of CSL Tours, reported that planning continues and that each student and chaperone going on the trip will be sent a festival letter which needs to be signed. **Comments** – New FOM member Jerry Leclerc stood up and expressed his sincere view regarding the confusion many new members feel about how to get involved in FOM activities. Many veteran FOM members responded with ideas on how FOM could improve upon this issue. Among the suggestions were: publishing the contact information of Executive Board members and fundraiser chairpersons on the web site and creating a liaison between Memorial middle school band students and parents and FOM.
